IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Please sign up by completing the online club form on the link above by 10am on WEDNESDAY 4TH DECEMBER at the latest. Any forms received after this date will only be included if spaces are available.
- Please select clubs in your order of preference (1st choice, 2nd choice 3rd choice etc.) on the form so places can be fairly distributed.
- Places in activities are limited so if an activity becomes oversubscribed, a waiting list will be kept in case places become available at a later date.
- Those who have a place at a paid club will be notified by a payment request on *ParentPay*. In these cases, all fees must be paid **before Monday 20**th **January**. Children may not be allowed to take part in an activity if payment hasn't been received by this date. Other clubs will be notified as soon as places are allocated.
- If, for any reason, your child no longer requires their place, please let the office know as soon as possible so the place can be offered to someone else. Where payment has been made, refunds will only be given if the place can be filled. Any weeks prior to the office receiving notice will have to be paid for.
- Children should be collected promptly after their activity from the main entrance of the school unless you indicate on the online form that your child may go home unaccompanied.
- Please note, if your child receives a place, they will need to attend each week and for the full session, unless the office is informed by a parent/carer through a note, phone call or in person. Regular failure to inform the school of non-attendance could result in your child losing their place.
- Regular non-attendance or late collection from after school activities could also mean your child losing their place.
