Questions about word meaning

Which word in lines 1-5 means the same as customers?

Questions that ask you to extract information from the passage

What is the name of the trapeze artist?

Questions that ask you to summarise the text

Describe what you know about Louie's job at the circus.

Questions that ask you to use the clues in the text to produce a reasoned answer

Why do you think the crowds are bigger when there is more danger?

Questions that ask you to use the text to make predictions

How do you think the evening performance will end?

Questions relating to the meaning of the whole text

Do you think the laudience has looked forward to looking to the circus? Explain your answer.

Questions about the author's choice of language

What does 'breath like smoke' (Line 20) tell us about the evening?

Questions that ask you to compare different parts of the text

How does the author compare the mood of the crowd before the performance to the mood suggested, during the performance?
