Year 6 Homework

Dear Parent/Carer,

As you know, in preparation for the SATs exams in May and your child's transition to secondary school, we have increased the amount of homework set for our year 6 children.

Your child is now being given GPS (grammar, punctuation and spelling) papers periodically to complete at home to support the learning they are doing in class. The next set of papers will be sent home today to be completed and returned to school on Tuesday 25th February.

Another set of papers will be sent home on Thursday 3rd April. These papers should be completed and returned to school on Wednesday 23rd April.

From Thursday 13th March, your child will bring home weekly maths homework. This homework will be sent home each Thursday and should be completed and returned to school by the following Wednesday.

The aim is for your child to be able to complete their work independently; if they find it too difficult, please let your child's teacher know via their home school diary.

Each piece of homework should take approximately 45 minutes to complete – please help your child to establish good routines about when and how to complete their work at home as establishing these now, in their final year at primary school, will support their transition to secondary school next year.
